#### **Executive Summary**

At the close of quarter 1, UNT is projecting a \$3.4M impact to fund balance for FY2020 by year-end, or \$1.9M less than budget [#1].

Total Revenues are projected to miss budget by \$10.5M or 1.3% due primarily to Tuition and Fees and All Other Revenue [#2]. Net Tuition & Fees missed quarter 1 budget projections by \$6.9m due to a minor variation in quarterly spread, slightly higher discounts & allowances, and average rate per student trending lower than anticipated for tuition [#3]. By year-end, the variance is anticipated to be 1.5% short of original budget estimates largely related to Discounts & Allowances. The large variance in Grants and Contracts is generated by an accelerated receipt of Texas Grants funding from the THECB [#4]. Historically, receipt of Texas Grants funding occurs in quarter 2, not quarter 1. Additionally, by year-end a \$5m negative variance is anticipated for additional state appropriations, represented in All Other Revenue category, related to payroll-related costs [#5]. Budget estimates assumed full utilization of the appropriation but actuals are limited to usage. Due to positive variances anticipated in Personnel Costs we do not believe full utilization is probable.

Total expenses are projected to come in under budget by \$12.1M or 1.8% [#5]. Maintenance & Operation Costs are trending positively but are believed to stabilize by year-end [#6]. Quarter 1 assumed spending would be greater due to the delay of non-essential expenses in FY2019. Capital Expenses are trending behind but will pick up due to purchases executed in Quarter 2 and Quarter 3 related to Datacom infrastructure improvements and equipment to support CAAAM efforts [#7].

Net transfers exceed budget projections by \$3.7m driven by additional Auxiliary transfers over to Plant for repairs and renovations [#8].

#### **Executive Summary**

At the close of quarter 1, UNT Health Science Center ended with a \$21.6m favorable impact to fund balances [#1], which is \$59m less than originally budgeted. UNTHSC is projecting to end FY2020 with a \$9.7m impact to fund balances, \$1m or 11.2% higher than budget.

Total revenues missed Q1 estimate by \$58.5m or 40.3% [#2]. This is driven primarily by overestimation of Q1 budget for State Appropriations, represented as All Other Revenue, due to budgeting all receipts in Q1 but recording it over the entire year [#3]. A decline in health care providers has resulted in lower than expected Net Professional Fees [#4]. This shortfall was offset by higher than anticipated correctional medicine revenues [#5].

Total expenses ecceded Q1 budget by \$1.4m or 2.7% [#6], primarily attributed to expenses related to increased services for correctional medicine and library subscriptions being higher than anticipated [#7]. Personnel Costs were under budget for Q1 and projecting to end the year \$6.5m under budget [#8]. Scholarships came in under budget but are still projected to be on budget by year-end [#9].

Transfers reflect a \$0.9m positive variance for Q1 but are expected to end FY20 \$0.5m below budget [#10].

#### **Executive Summary**

At the close Q1, UNT Dallas ended with a \$18.6m favorable impact to fund balances for FY20 [#1], which is \$350k more than originally budgeted.

Total revenues were greater than FY20 Q1 budget by \$340k [#2]. This is driven primarily by Grants and Contracts revenue being higher than anticipated in Q1 due to an increase in PELL Grant Revenue [#3].

Total expenses for Q1 were basically flat to budget, and projecting to be \$340k over budget for year-end forecast [#4]. This is primarily attributed to higher Personnel Costs than budgeted [#5].

Transfers were flat for Q1, and also projecting to be flat for year-end forecast [#6].

#### **Executive Summary**

At the close of Q1, UNT System Administration ended with a \$31m favorable impact to fund balances for FY20 [#1], which is \$30m more than originally budgeted.

Total revenues were greater than FY20 Q1 budget by \$4.9m [#2]. This is driven primarily by timing of State Appropriations being posted in Q1, and budgeted over the year [#3].

Total expenses for Q1 were basically flat to budget [#4]. Individual areas of variance include Maintenance & Operations Costs which exceeded the budget by \$414k [#5], due largely to IT Telecom charges that were unanticipated in the budget. This overage was offset by lower than expected Personnel Costs [#6].

Transfers reflect a \$24.4m positive variance due primarily to legislative transfers for debt service budgeted over the year, but posted in Q1 [#7].
